Administering these procedures and following the below tips can assist you in getting the most value for your cattle.

<u>Consign Cattle Prior to a Sale</u>: When consigning cattle prior to the sale, Equity Livestock staff can advertise your cattle in our consignment listing. We are then able to notify potential buyers that your livestock will be available and allow us to get more buyers at the sale. Contact your local Equity Livestock market to consign your cattle.

Provide Veterinary Records: Cattle with veterinary records indicating that they are vaccinated and wormed are more appealing to buyers. Cattle with no treatment or records may sell at a lower price. Consult with your veterinarian for the most effective protocol for your herd.
